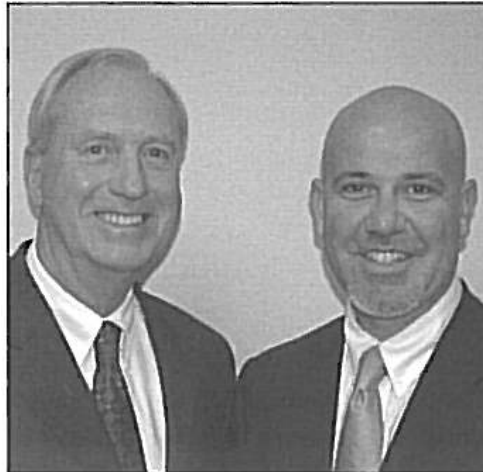
Awardees
